Admission Requirements

- 🛡️ Must hold a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university
- 🛡️ Submit transcripts from all higher education institutions attended
- 🛡️ Submit a statement of professional goals
- 🛡️ Submit a current resume
- 🛡️ Have an overall GPA of 3.0 or a GPA of 2.5 on the last 30 undergraduate hours
- 🛡️ Submit two letters of recommendation
- 🛡️ Hold a current unencumbered RN license
- 🛡️ Clear healthcare provider criminal background check through the Mississippi Department of Health or equivalent
