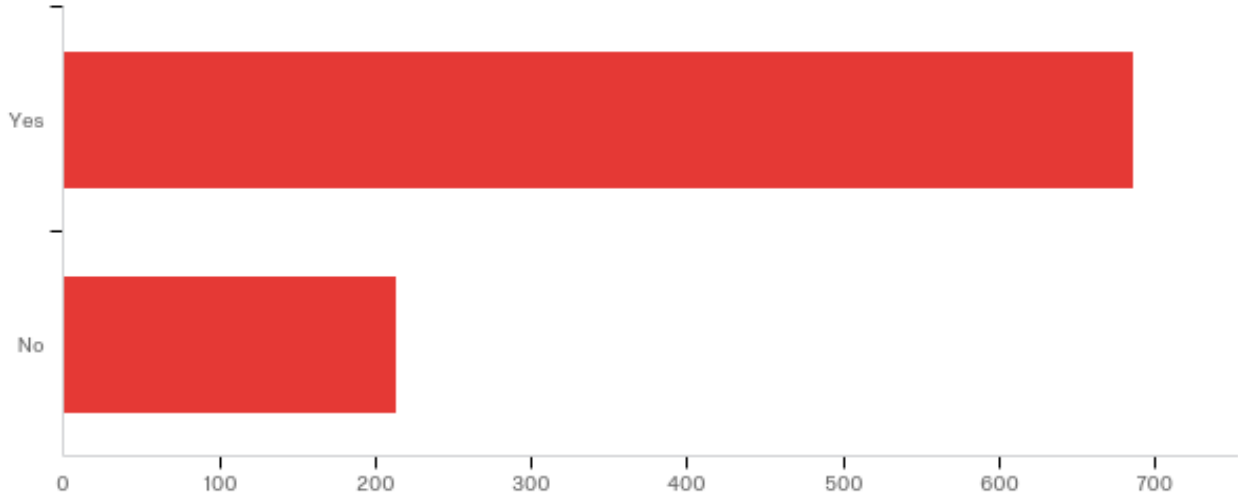

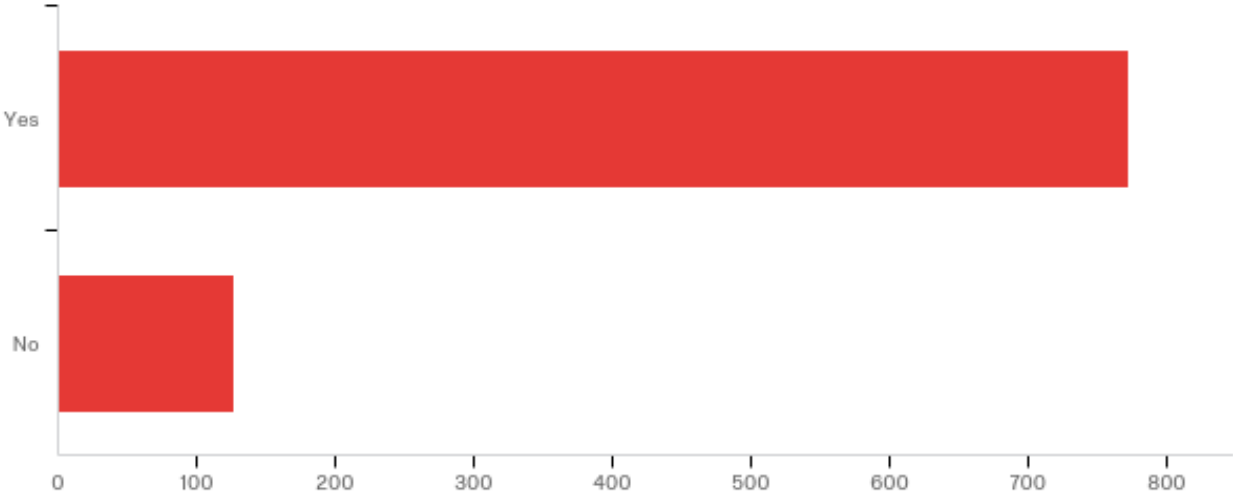
Q16 - Are you currently teaching?

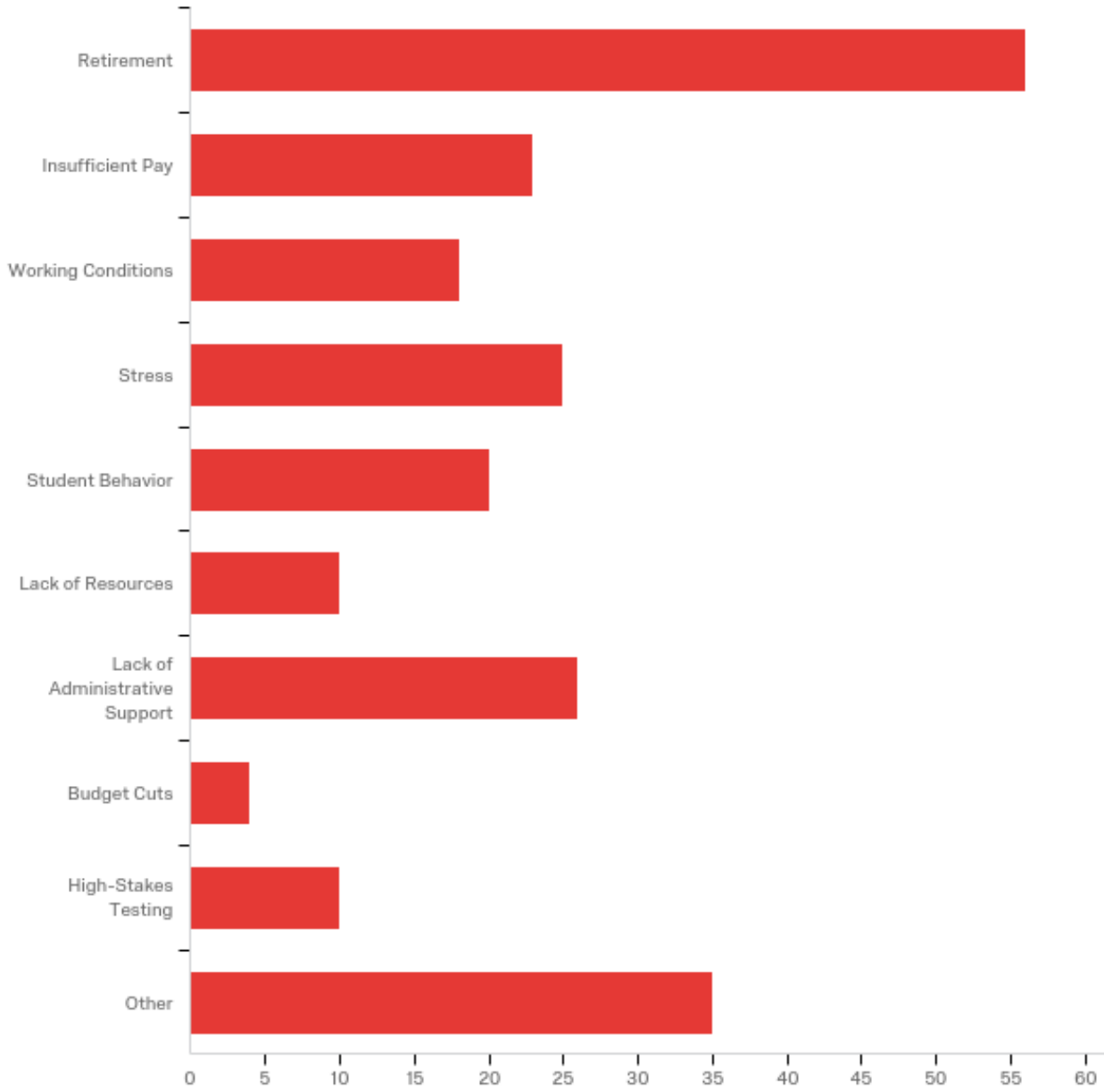
Q17 - How many years have you worked as a licensed educator?

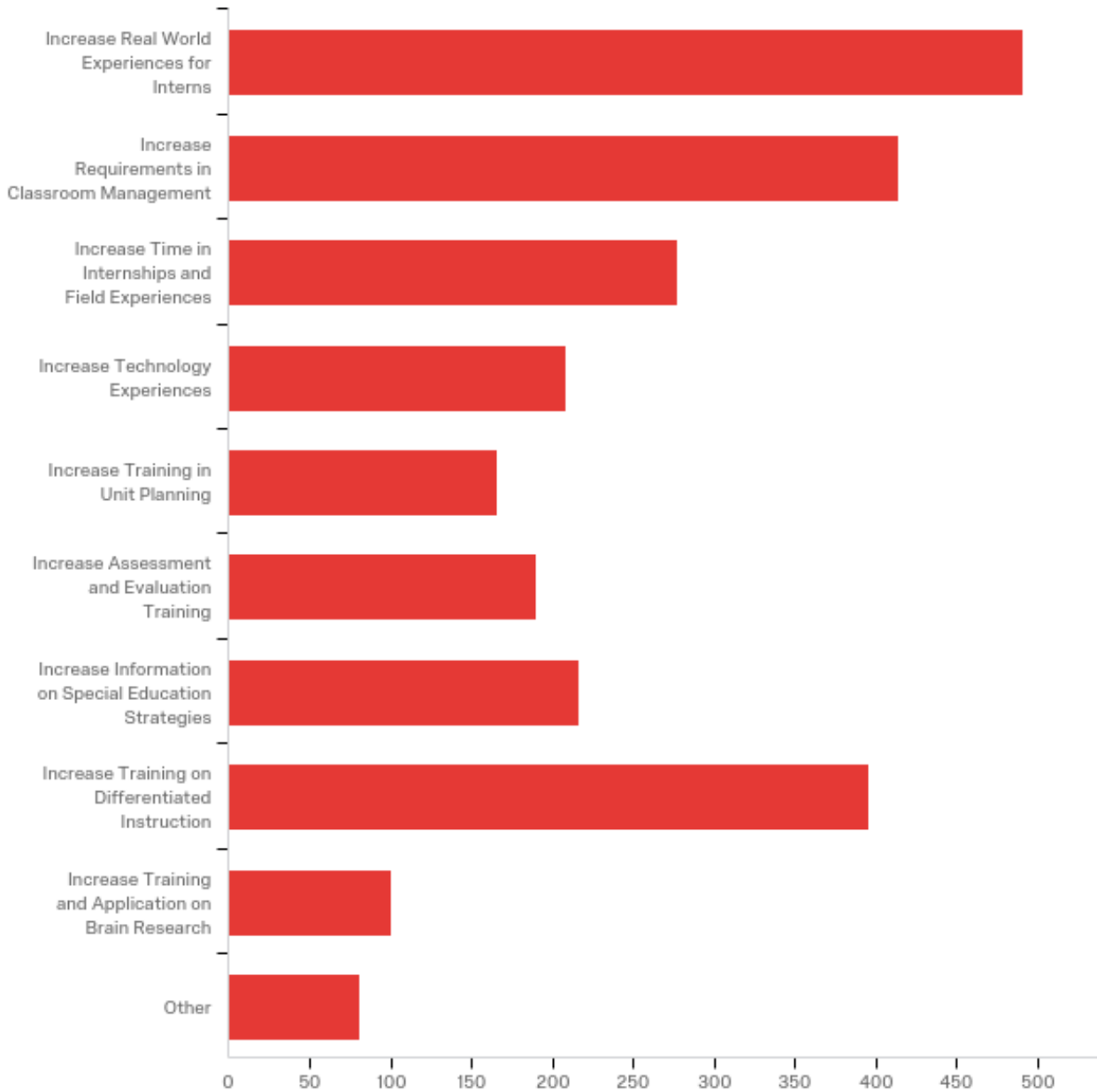
